From the Pastor's Desk

No Ordinary Man

For next Sunday, the second Sunday in the Lenten Season, we will return to our reading in "The Story," and focus on Chapter 24, 'No Ordinary Man.' As our readings set up we will be reading the chapter on the Resurrection for Easter Sunday, and then wrap up the book on the next four Sundays after Easter.

How appropriate it is that we are able to focus our reading and study during these Lenten Sundays on Jesus Himself. Through the parables, the Sermon on the Mount, the teachings to his disciples, the miracles over nature, and the miracles of healing Jesus demonstrated what it meant to lead a life devoted to following Him. Sadly we see that even then, as now, not all were convinced that Jesus was truly who He claimed to be. While many others saw their lives dramatically changed by their encounter with the Son of God.

For next Sunday, March 8, read Chapter 24 of "The Story," or from your Bible, Matthew 5-7; 9; 14; Mark 4-6; Luke 10; 15; and John 6. And ponder this question: Jesus explained that he is the "bread of life" – the source of sustenance and satisfaction. What can you do to gain a deeper satisfaction in your relationship with Jesus?
