James 1:12: Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love Him.

This passage reminds me of a favorite story and movie "Rudy" about a young man who wanted to play football for Notre Dame. Through very hard work, he managed to get accepted by Notre Dame and even got accepted to the team. But he wanted to actually play just one game, just so his father could see him play. Frustrated, he spoke to a priest about his difficulties and wanted to know why God did not seem to be hearing his prayers and allow him to play. The priest's response was: "There are two things I can tell you with absolute certainty - there is a God, and I'm not Him." In the end, he did play. Both this passage from James and this (very true) story demonstrate that even the most difficult things in life are part of God's plan for us all.

Praise be to our Father in heaven, who helps us in so many, unexpected and wonderful ways!

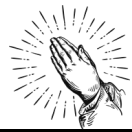

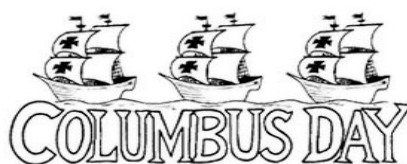
