Thank you for joining us this morning to worship Christ and to celebrate the retirement of Reverend Dr. Kerry P. Maurer.

Pastor Kerry was called to St. Luke on October 5, 1986. At that time, the church was located in Lightstreet with two worship services each Sunday and communion twice a month. He spiritually led the congregation closer to Christ and, in December of 1998, physically helped move the congregation to the building you see today. By 2008, the congregation had grown to three services with 350 people worshipping each Sunday. At that time Pastor Kerry transitioned to a new church in Cumming, GA.

In 2018, Pastor Kerry was called once again to St. Luke as an interim pastor to spiritually lead us - this time to the NALC and once again closer to Christ.

We are forever grateful to him, his wife Angie, and their entire family for their love, support and friendship over the years.

The year 2020 has been one of tremendous change and challenge. History scholars will look back on this year for generations to come, and it is only fitting that Pastor Kerry, being a history buff, would see us through this incredible time and transition.

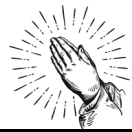
