Last Monday night was brutal in the ER. Lots of sick people; so many that there seemed to be no end of people in the waiting room. Twice as many patients as we had beds. While we were adequately staffed, there were still an overwhelming number of needs to be met. There seemed to be no end to this tidal wave of sick people. And then around midnight, the wave subsided. They stopped coming in the door. In the next few hours, we caught up, and eventually cleared out all of the patients except a few admission holdovers. The night ended on a relaxed note. We were to find out the next day that we had seen the all-time record number of patients for that facility.

Whie away on assignment, I stay at AirBNB lodgings. I prefer this to hotels. As I have been at my current assignment for several months, I have gotten to know my hosts. The one is a retired nurse. Her name is Dawn. She and her family are all believers. A few days after the night mentioned above, I saw Dawn in passing. She stopped me and asked, "What happened Monday night? I woke up just after eleven with an urge to pray for you and your team."

I certainly had uttered lots of little prayers, and so had my friend, Dr. Joel, as we went about that night. I also know that Dawn's prayers helped us over the tide. And the entire event was orchestrated to help build our faith, as well as to help lots of hurting people.

There is power in prayer. God listens to the heartfelt thoughts of His children. Our Heavenly Father will even awaken one of His children to pray for another of His children, not because He wants to hold some power over us, but rather to build our faith. Knowing that we are connected to a real, living, loving Heavenly Father, and to each other, is an encouragement and a builder of faith in us. Every once in a while, we all need evidence that God is real and that He loves us. Why? Because we are human, and the troubles of this life sometimes distract us from the grace, mercy, and love of our God. So, because He loves us so much, He reminds us of our connection to one another and to Him.

Thank you, Father, for Dawn, for Joel, for the rest of our team, and for loving us all so much.
